

GUIDELINES FOR DISTRIBUTION OF TELEVISION

A. OBJECTIVE

The objective of the scheme is to provide grants to families belonging to ST/OBC community of Assam for availing information and knowledge. Television is a medium of information and knowledge through the broadcast of various news, infomercials, programmes, etc. Also known as an Internet TV, a Smart TV is any TV that can provide additional programs through internet connectivity. It's like having a computer built into your TV. Under the scheme, SMART Television with the facilities of watching television programmes, connecting to internet, mobile connectivity, etc. will be provided.

B. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- i) The applicant must be the head of the family belonging to ST/OBC community of Assam
- ii) The family must not own any SMART TV (To be ascertained by Principal Secretaries-Autonomous Councils, PD-ITDPs and SDWOs)

C. SELECTION COMMITTEES

The selection of beneficiaries will be done by any of the following committees at the District/Sub-Divisional level:

- i) Development Board at Sub-Divisional Welfare for ST/OBC for Sub-Divisional Office/ Project Implementation Committee (PIC) at Sub-Divisional Office for ST (if already notified by the Govt.)
- ii) Project Implementation Committee (PIC) at Integrated Tribal Development Project for ST (if already notified by the Govt.)

OR

In case of non notification of PIC/ST Development Board at Sub-Divisional Welfare /OBC Development Board at Sub-Divisional Welfare/PIC at Sub-Divisional Office for ST, the Principal Secretary of KAAC/NCHAC or the Deputy Commissioner of the District will form a Selection Committee for the respective allocated offices.

D. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION OF BENEFICIARIES

- The Sub-Divisional Welfare Offices/ITDPs/The Principal Secretaries of NCHAC/KAAC will provide advertisement calling for applications
- The Selection Committee as per Point No. C will scrutinize the applications and select the beneficiaries on need basis for distribution of the grants/items
- The Selection Committee has to select beneficiaries belonging to ST/OBC community.

E. IMPLEMENTATION PROCEDURE OF THE SCHEMES

- The allocation will be provided SDWO/ITDP/Autonomous Council wise
- The allocation will be communicated to the SDWO/ITDP/Autonomous Council
- The PD-ITDPs/SDWOs/PS-Autonomous Councils will prepare a list of beneficiaries as per Point No. D by providing advertisement in various mediums
- The grants will be delivered to the respective PD-ITDPs/SDWOs/PS-Autonomous Councils on receipt of sanction from the Govt.
- On receipt of grants, the same has to be distributed to the beneficiaries within 15 (Fifteen) without fail avoiding any unnecessary stocking of the grants.
- The PD-ITDPs/SDWOs/PS-Autonomous Councils will maintain the APRs, Documents of the beneficiaries, etc. for future Audit, Inspection purpose, etc.
- On completion of distribution of the grants to the beneficiaries, the PD-ITDPs/SDWOs/PS-Autonomous Councils will submit the list of beneficiaries and Utilization Certificates in 12-C Format to the Director, WPT & BC, Assam
